BEAR STREET

NEW RESTAURANTS



SAFFRON INDIAN BISTRO

Banff's newest Indian Bistro features traditional Thali's of delicious Indian food with a variety of Tandoori sizzlers – all centred around one of the most precious and expensive spices in the world – saffron.



LUPO ITALIAN RESTAURANT

Banff Hospitality Collective recently added a taste of Italy to the town's vibrant culinary scene. Lupo (Italian for wolf) specializes in house-made pasta, woodfired pizzas and a talented chef team, grilling tender meats and seafood in an open-concept kitchen.

SKI RESORT UPDATES



LAKE LOUISE SKI RESORT

Juniper Express, a new high-speed quad, officially opened on February 3rd, 2022. This chair offers quick access to five new blue runs as well as the Easy Street green run.



MT. NORQUAY

Mt. Norquay is the first ski resort in Canada to switch to 100% clean, green energy. It's now running 100% on renewable power, generated from a blend of wind and lowimpact hydropower from Canadian renewable energy facilities.



BANFF SUNSHINE

Last year, Banff Sunshine installed one of the largest solar panel systems in Banff National Park (roughly 3,250 square feet). The new 60.2 kW solar panel system will power the resort's Transportation Centre, with surplus power exported back to the grid.
